The Password Vault has been designed to provide a secure area where you can store passwords to any site or other websites or resources that require a username and password to log in.

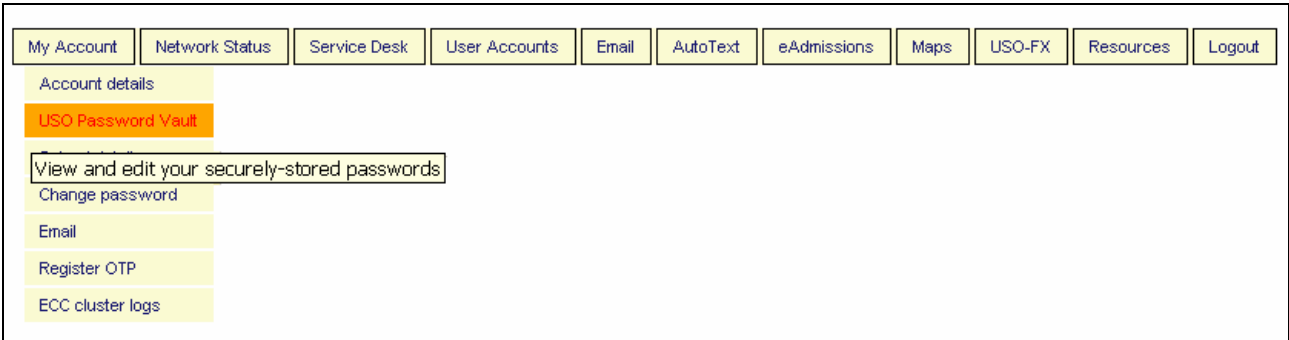
This facility is available to every user with a USO account.

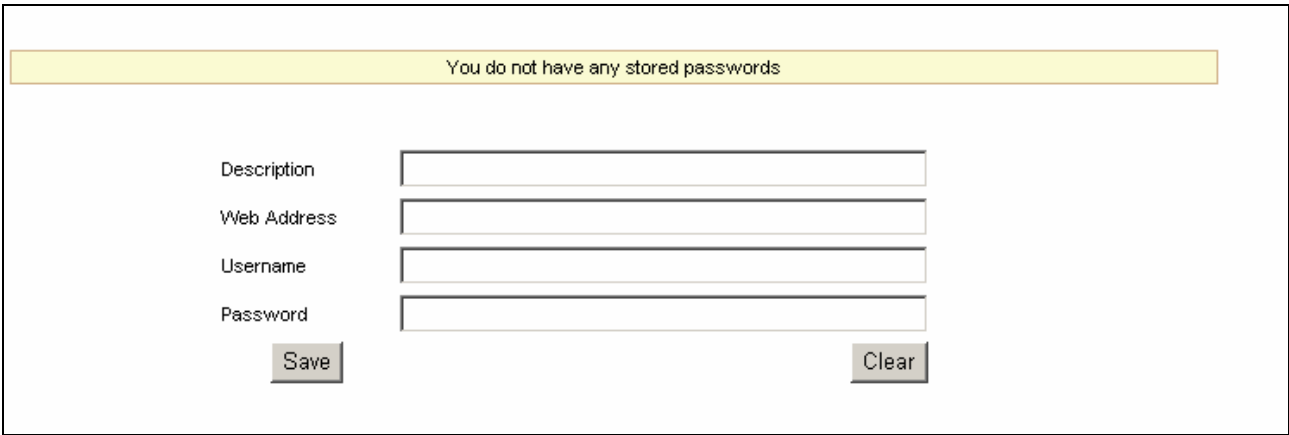
